



Sexism is Only Form Dominance Takes

- ▶ True men are dominant and use violence to maintain that.
- ► Men and traits associated as masculine are more valuable.

▶ Domination hierarchies and the entitlement inherent in them are the tap roots of all forms of violence and injustice. (racial, gender, economic injustice, etc.)

Partnership Societies

- ► Mutual trust and low degree of fear and social violence
- ► Equal valuing of males and females
- ► Generally egalitarian social structure; hierarchies of actualization
- ► Myths and stories honor partnership and present it as normal

Domination Societies

- ► High degree of fear and violence
- ► Ranking of male half of humanity over female half (& gender non-conforming)
- ► Authoritarian social structure; hierarchies of domination
- ► Myths and stories idealize domination and violence, and present them as normal

Dichotomy: Division into two especially mutually exclusive or contradictory groups or entities



Comparison of Assumptions

Dominator: Partnership:

- **▶** Power is finite.
- ► Power comes from power over others.
- **▶** Differences are threatening.
- ► Some people/groups have greater worth.

- **▶** Power is infinite.
- **▶** Power flows both ways.
- **Diversity enriches and strengthens.**
- ► All have inherent worth.

Much of the conflict in our society comes from the tension between these two sets of assumptions.

Dominator Society Beliefs

- Dominance by Some is Normal and Right
- ***We Lose If We're not in Control**
- Might Makes Right
- Anything Different Must Be Bad
- *Diverse Viewpoints Aren't Valid
- Problems are Deserved
- *****We're in Control; We Know Best

Controlling Partners Beliefs

- **❖ I'm Entitled; My Needs and Wants Come First**
- **❖** If I'm not in Control, You're Controlling Me
- My Way is the Right Way and I Must Do Whatever It Takes to
 Maintain Control
- ❖ I'm Okay; You're not Okay if You Differ
- **❖** Your Needs/Wants/Feelings/Opinions Aren't Valid
- **You Made Me Hurt You**
- **❖ I Control You Because I Love You**

Doublethink

Doublethink refers to the holding of opposing beliefs without cognitive dissonance.

- Values of "love your neighbor" coexist with those that permit demonize people.
- > Victims' partners espouse loving them while also controlling and abusing them.
- We struggle to hold those we're angry with in the light and see the Christ within them.

Eisler says to let our awareness and action "dance."
