POST-CANVASS BUDGET

With 12 families yet to be canvassed, 37 units have pledged \$7,812. In order to bring the operating budget in line with the pledges received, reductions in publicity, hospitality, summer clerical salary, and eight other items were approved by the Board. The revisions reduce the total operating budget, including a 10% contingency fund, to \$5,736.

In addition to approving a revised operating budget, the Oct. 2 Board meeting

--approved the appointment of Betsy Roberts and Hermine Davidson to the Social Action committee, and Delores Frank to the Long Range Planning committee.

--authorized Rachel and Bob Siegfried to represent the Prairie Society at the Central Midwest District Annual Meeting in Rockford, Oct. 31 to Nov. 2.

--agreed to add \$2500 carried over from last year to the difference between the total operating budget and the pledges received to make ~~\$4500~~ available for a minister during a portion of this year.
