UPHAM WOODS WEEKEND

The Fall-camp weekend at Upham Woods (we are changing the name from family retreat) will be October 23, 24, and 25. We want to emphasize that this is for everyone, singles, couples, and family. We want to bridge for a while, that generation gap.

Upham Woods Camp is owned by the University of Wisconsin. It is located 2 miles northwest of Wisconsin Dells on the west side of the Wisconsin River. There are 318 acres in the camp property including the 100 acre Blackhawk Island. The building area (including lodge, mess hall, dormitory cabins, etc.) is on the old channel of the Wisconsin River. A great variety of flora, scenery, Indian history, rock formations and caves make this a most interesting campsite for education, adventure, and outdoor living. A five minute walk into the woods returns you to untouched nature.

You are invited to bring your own canoes, cameras and musical instruments. Sleeping rooms have double-decked bunks, some single cots, mattresses, pillows, and mattress covers. But you will need to bring sheets, pillow cases and plenty of blankets or sleeping bags.

We will have a cook available and all food (excluding special diets) will be provided.

Everyone is expected to help with the clean-up and other camp duties. Baby-sitters will be available for specified periods during the morning, afternoon, and evening hours.

Directions for reaching camp are as follows: Turn off I-90-94 at North Wisconsin Dells exit, go east to stoplight (Hwy 12), turn left (north) & mile to County Trunk A, turn right, drive through railroad underpass. The Upham Woods Gate is & mile beyond the underpass. If approaching from the east, drive west through Wisconsin Dells, cross the River to stoplight, Junction Hwy I2, turn right (north) & mile, turn right on County Trunk A, and proceed through railroad underpass, camp is % mile beyond the underpass.
