The general theme for religious education at Prairie Society during 1971-72 will be "What does it mean to be a human being in today's world?"

There will be no structure for the crib through three-year-olds and volunteers will change from week to week taking care of the little ones.

Four and five year olds, with Pat Cautley as their teacher, will discover "I learn to know my world through my senses."

Melinda Roznoy will teach the first and second graders "What does it mean to be different?"

Third, fourth and fifth grades will discuss "How do we make sense out of the world?" Clark Edwards will lead the discussion, using the mythology text called Man the Meaning Maker.

Vivian Meyer will teach the sixth graders. They will discuss "How do I resolve conflicts and make decisions?"

No structure has yet been set for the seventh and eighth grades; planning will be done by participants. John Hempstead will be the teacher.
